ALL WORK SHALL BE IN STRICT CONFORMITY WITH BOCA, OSHA, MIOSHA, AND ALL REGULATIONS AND CODES APPLICABLE TO THE TRADE AFFECTED.

THIS CONTRACTOR SHALL REMOVE ALL RUBBISH, AND DIRT RESULTING FROM HIS WORK, FROM THE BUILDING, SUCH RUBBISH, AND DIRT SHALL BE REMOVED NOT ONLY ON COMPLETION OF THE MORK, BUT ALSO AT SUCH OT THE RUBBISH MAY ACCUMULATE TO THE EXTENT OF INTERFERING MITH THE CONSTRUCTION MORK, AND/OR MITH OPERATING OF THE EXISTING BUILDING.

GUARANTEE SHALL BE EFFECTIVE FOR A PERIOD OF ONE (I) YEAR FROM DATE OF FINAL CERT SPECIFICATIONS FOR EXTENDED WARRANTY.

SHOULD ANY DEFECTS APPEAR DURING THE PERIOD OF THE GUARANTEE, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL MAKE GOOD ANY SUCH DEFECTS, REPLACING ALL MATERIALS EFFECTED THEREBY, AND MAKE GOOD ANY DAMAGE TO MORK AND MATERIALS INSTALL BY HIM UNDER HIS CONTRACT.

AT THE COMPLETION OF HIS WORK, THE MECHANICAL CONTRACTOR SHALL REMOVE ALL DEMO EQUIPMENT, REFUSE AND DIRT, MAKE ANY AND ALL ADJUSTMENTS REQUIRED, AND LEAVE HIS WORK IN CLEAN AND PROPER WORKING ORDER.

BEFORE SUBMITTING PROPOSALS FOR THE WORK, EACH BIDDER SHALL BE HELD TO HAVE EXAMINED THE PREMISES, AND SATISFIED HIMSELF AS TO THE EXISTING CONDITIONS UNDER WHICH HE WILL BE OBLIGED TO WORK IN PERFORMING HIS PART OF THE WORK. NO EXTRAS WILL BE ALLOWED THE CONTRACTOR ON ACCOUNT OF HIS FAILURE TO MAKE THE ABOVE MENTIONED EXAMINATION OR NEGLECT TO INCLUDE ALL MATERIALS, AND LABOR REQUIRED TO COMPLETE THE WORK.
